KiD - Kindergarten in Diani e.V. ん(i)

Our kindergarten is located in Diani Beach, Kenya, about 40 km south of Mombasa. It was established in March 2003 by a couple from Bremen/Germany, Heike and Heinz Isbrecht, who first visited this impoverished region in 1993, and became increasingly concerned about the welfare of its children.

KiD's students receive instruction from qualified primary school teachers. They also receive meals and funding for all necessary health care. But KiD's commitment extends beyond early childhood: we provide financial and motivational backing, and educational tracking, to allows our "graduates" to continue their education through the secondary level.

KiD's popular program has meant steady expansion on our site, starting with a stone kindergarten building, a children's bathroom house, and a water tower in 2006. In 2007, we fully furnished the classrooms, and built a separate kitchen house. A used school bus, bought in 2008, now brings the children safely to and from school.

In 2011, we started an early elementary-level program, welcoming 22 new students from the area. In 2012, we built a separate, four-classroom elementary schoolhouse. Currently, KiD supports 175 children - 64 kindergarteners, and 111 elementary school students.

KiD's financial goal is to become self-supporting. Thus, in response to rapid increases in Kenyan food prices, KiD bought land for a garden, which now provides the bulk of our food.
